

Identify and support digital health companies with solutions that address key healthcare challenges in Massachusetts



Innovations to Support Women+ Health

Rock Health coined the term "women+ health" to encompass the health needs of cisgender women, transgender individuals, non-binary individuals, and others whose health relates to cisgender women.

Key Areas of Opportunity



Reproductive Health& Menopause

- Supporting the 6.1 million US women who struggle with reproductive disorders
- Addressing the loss of economic productivity and healthcare costs because of menopause





- Expanding access to maternity care services
- Decreasing the rate of maternal death, of which 84% of cases are preventable
- Addressing inequities and maternal complications for women of color



- Supporting the emotional impact on women+ who experience sexual violence
- Addressing the risk of suicide linked to postpartum depression





- Addressing the 2X mortality rate for women+'s heart attacks
- Decreasing the mortality
 rate of gynecological
 cancers

Eligibility and Review Criteria

- Eligibility:
 - Startups with a new solution, not yet widely commercially available;
 - No minimum requirement of revenue or investment but companies that have participated in an accelerator program will receive preference;
 - Not limited to MA companies, but MeHI has set a goal of 50% of participating companies having a presence in MA;
- Review Criteria:
 - Potential to support womens+ health;
 - Uniqueness in the market; and
 - Potential commercial viability
